

encourage fellows-in-training to submit their work for the Young Investigators' Awards. Please let us know what we can do to improve and strengthen your Organization.





Dr. Vijay is a noninvasive cardiologist and Vice President at Scottsdale Cardiovascular Center and Director of the Heart Failure Program. He is also Chair of Scientific Research Committee at Scottsdale Healthcare Clinical Research Institute, Scottsdale, Arizona. He has been in Arizona for more than 23 years and maintains an active clinical practice in Scottsdale. Dr.



former Chief Medical Officer, Chief Physician, Cardiologist and Head of the Department of Medicine and Cardiology at the Central Railway Headquarters Hospital in Mumbai. Previously he served at the Royal Hospital, Muscat, Oman for more than 3 years in the Department of Cardiology on deputation from India. 
