Shashin Desai, M.D., graduated from the University of Natal (South Africa) School of Medicine in 1980. 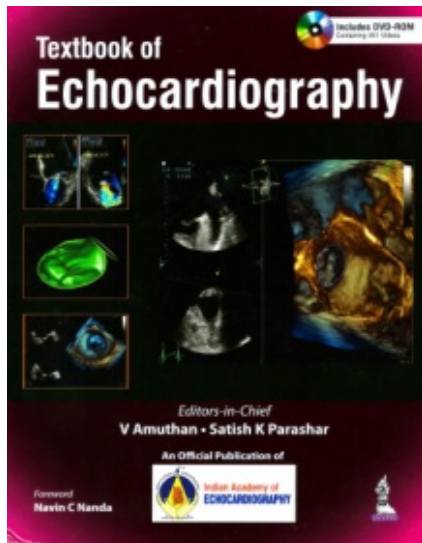
