

Dr. Naresh Parikh of Atlanta, Georgia will be honored at this meeting. Dr. Parikh graduated from Nagpur Medical College, Nagpur, India and did his training in internal medicine and cardiology in New Jersey and New York. He has been in active cardiology practice in the Atlanta

area for over 20 years. He has served as the President of the Georgia Association of Physicians of India and also as the President and CEO of the Georgia Clinic. He has been very active in community affairs in Georgia and has helped establish a charitable medical clinic in Atlanta under the auspices of BAPS and has conducted many health camps. He has also helped conduct surveys of the prevalence of coronary artery disease, stroke and related risk factors such as diabetes and hypertension in Asian Indians living in the State of Georgia. This work was recently published. He has previously hosted AACIO meetings in Atlanta and has been selected as the Convention Chairman of the American Association of Physicians of India meeting to be held in Atlanta next year.
