DR. MASOOD AHMAD To Be Honored by AACIO

Masood Ahmad, M.D. is Professor of Medicine in the Division of Cardiology and Medical Director of the Echocardiography Laboratory at the University of Texas Medical Branch, Galveston, Texas. Prior to joining the Cardiology Division at UTMB in 1981. Dr. Ahmad was Associate Professor of Medicine and Director of the Echocardiography Laboratory at the University of Missouri Columbia and served as Chief of the Cardiology section at the Harry S. Truman Memorial VA Hospital, also in Columbia, Missouri, from 1978-1981. Dr. Ahmad completed medical school in Kashmir, India; medical residency and cardiology fellowship at Long Island Jewish Medical Center, New York and at Parkland Memorial Hospital/Southwestern Medical School in Dallas, Texas. He is board certified in internal medicine (1975),

cardiovascular diseases (1979) and in echocardiography (1996, 2005). Dr. Ahmad is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians, American College of Cardiology, American Heart Association, American Society of Echocardiography and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons in Canada. His special interests include application of noninvasive imaging techniques in evaluation of ischemic heart disease. He has contributed to research in cardiovascular nuclear medicine, cardiac magnetic resonance imaging and echocardiography. He has published 75 articles in peer reviewed scientific journals. Dr. Ahmad's current interests include 3D stress echocardiography and evaluation of new ultrasound contrast agents for assessment of myocardial perfusion.

Cheema received the Dr. Madhukar Deshmukh Young Investigator's Award and presented an abstract on "US11218, a PDGFR and VEGFR2 Inhibitor Blocks Adventitial Angiogenesis and Prevents Intimal Hyperplasia after Coronary Stenting in a Porcine Model".

Dr. Nanda - Ellis Island Award 2006

Dr. Navin C. Nanda, Professor of Medicine and Director, Heart Station/
Echocardiography Laboratories, at the University of Alabama at Birmingham, was selected by the Board of Directors and the Selection Committee of the National Ethnic Coalition of Organizations (NECO) as a recipient of the 2006 Ellis Island Medal of Honor. The official Award ceremony was held in the historic Great Hall on Ellis Island near the Statue of Liberty in New York on May 13, 2006. It ranks as one of the nation's most prestigious and highest civilian

awards and is officially recognized and sanctioned by the United States Congress (both the House of Representatives and the Senate). The awardees' names are also listed in the Congressional Record.
