

More Honors for Dr. Navin Nanda

Dr. Navin Nanda, MD, DSc (Hon), Distinguished Professor of Medicine and Cardiovascular Disease at the University of Alabama at Birmingham, Birmingham, Alabama was presented the Lifetime Achievement Award by the American Society of Echocardiography during their annual meeting in Nashville in June this year. This is the Society's most prestigious award and a testament to his life's work. Among the achievements cited were his publication of 13 books and over 500 original scientific manuscripts, his organization of yearly case-based educational conferences prior to American Heart Association and American College of Cardiology Annual Scientific Sessions, the latter running currently for 34 years, his formation of the International Society of Cardiovascular Ultrasound in 1991 and organization of highly successful World Congresses of Echocardiography held over 24 years.
